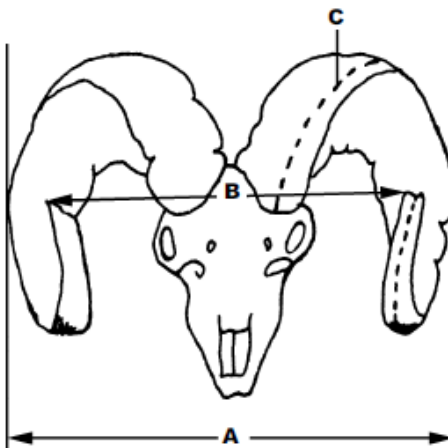

## BRIEF INSTRUCTIONS FOR MEASURING SHEEP

Measurements must be made with a flexible steel tape and recorded to the nearest one-eighth of an inch. To simplify addition, please enter fractional figures in eighths and in proper fractions:

- A. Greatest Spread** is measured between perpendiculars, at right angles to the center line of the skull.
- B. Tip to Tip Spread** is measured between tips of horns.
- C. Length of Horn** is measured from lowest point in front, on outer curve, to a point in line with tip. **DO NOT** press tape into depressions. The low point of the outer curve of the horn is considered to be the low point of the frontal portion of the horn, situated above and slightly medial to the eye socket (not on the outside edge of the horn). Use a straight edge, perpendicular to horn axis, to end measurement.

**Drying Period:** To be eligible for entry in the Records, a trophy must first have been stored under normal room temperature and humidity for at least 60 days after date of kill. No trophy will be considered which has been altered in any way from its natural state.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR MAYA BOWHUNTERS BIG GAME RECORDS & AWARDS PROGRAM

- 1. Scoring form** completed by active member and submitted to Hunting VP of Maya Bowhunters by February 1<sup>st</sup>.
- 2. Completion of 'Fair Chase Affidavit'** on the back of the scoring form.
- 3. At least one photo of the horns.** Three photos preferred (a view from the front side, a view from the left side and a view from the right side). A field photo is also requested, if possible. Digital photos preferred.

## RULES OF FAIR CHASE

The term "Fair Chase" shall not include the taking of animals under the following conditions:

- 1. Helpless in a trap, deep snow or water, or on ice.
- 2. From any power vehicle or power boat.
- 3. By spotlighting at night.
- 4. By the use of any tranquilizers or poisons.
- 5. While inside escape-proof fenced enclosures.
- 6. By the use of any power vehicle or power boats for herding or driving animals, including use of aircraft to land alongside or to communicate with or direct a hunter on the ground.
- 7. By the use of electronic devices for attracting, locating or pursuing game or guiding the hunter to such game or by the use of a bow or arrow to which any electronic device is attached.

The fair chase concept does, however, extend beyond the hunt itself; it is an attitude and a way of life based in a deep-seated respect for wildlife, the environment, and for other individuals who share in bowhunting.
