- ◆ 30 - 3-D targets.
- ◆ 10-8 Scoring
- ◆ Two arrows shot at each target (field points only)
- ◆ Longbow and primitive styles must shoot wood arrows
- ◆ Recurve style may use aluminum or carbon arrows
- ◆ All styles - index finger must touch the nock
- ◆ String walking is prohibited
- ◆ Six divisions for men and women (Adult, Senior, Silver Senior, Master Senior, Young Adult/ Youth and Cub)
- ◆ Young adult, youth and cub combined into one style
- ◆ No sights or rangefinders (unmarked yardage)
- ◆ Bring Flu Flu arrows for Flying Goose

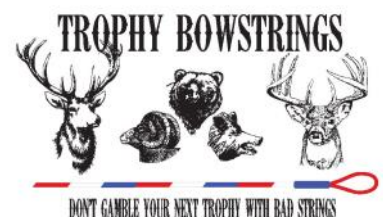
