Next meetings, Wednesday Dec. 14th and Jan. 11th, 7pm at the Maya Clubhouse. The California Fish and Wildlife Strategic Vision Commission have started their work on the possibility of changing how the Fish and Game Commission and the Department of Fish and Game function. Update; the first draft has been written and posted for review. Several meetings have been scheduled across the state for questions and comments or you can email your comments if unable to attend a schedule meeting. Petitions to make changes to the CBH/SAA and/or NFAA Constitution and/or Bylaws have been submitted. NFAA and CBH/SAA members interested in reviewing what changes the petitions make can attend the next Nor Cal or Maya general meetings to review the documents. Maya members who also belong to NFAA and/or CBH/SAA will vote on the petitions at the Jan. 3rd general meeting. The results will be taken to the Jan. 11th Nor Cal meeting where the other clubs will also have their results. The regional vote results will be taken by the Nor Cal reps to the CBH/SAA annual meeting Jan 20th through the 22nd. All regions will then present their votes to finalize on how CBH/SAA stands on the NFAA petitions and what changes will be implemented to CBH/SAA.

Next class dates are Saturdays Dec. 17th, Jan. 28th, Feb. 18th and March 17th from 10am to 12 noon. These classes are held at the site in range far right side.

During these classes the site in range is still open except for the 20 yard target for safety reasons. Thanks to all the members who have used the site in range while the classes have been held to keep safety as a priority.

A few members have asked about the All Skills Archery Classes for their friends or youth who want to experience or be introduced to archery but don't have equipment that fits them. The Maidu Museum contracts Maya to hold these classes. Contact them at 774-5934 for information and costs or to register for a class. Age is limited to 7 year olds and up including adults. We use recurve and Genesis bows, focus on consistent shooting form fundamentals, safety and of course have fun while learning archery for a couple of hours in a group setting. All instructors are certified through USA Archery or National Archery in the Schools Program. There are other options available for instructions, after school or intermediate/advanced classes, contact me for more information.
