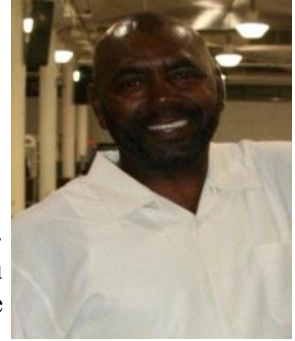

What is Nor Cal? The full name for this regional group is Nor Cal Bowhunters. They represent the areas 7 archery/bowhunting clubs and 2 archery pro shops to California Bowmen Hunters State Archery Association (CBHSAA). CBHSAA and Nor Cal are chartered to the National Field Archery Association (NFAA). What does Nor Cal and CBHSAA do for Archery or Bowhunting? There are many facets to their representation of Archery and Bowhunting. CBHSAA is "Dedicated to Promoting and Protecting the Archery and Bowhunting Heritages". This statewide organization speaks for California Archers and Bowhunters in matters concerning Legislation and Regulation

since 1943. The Legislative committee of CBHSAA includes a Coordinator, 6 state area reps and each region group has one legislative representative. Archery is a shooting sport so at times issues arise to limit or exclude the shooting of Bows and Arrows for any purpose. CBHSAA will pursue those actions for the benefit of all Archers and Bowhunters.

California Bowmen Hunters State Archery Association (CBHSAA) has petitioned the California Fish and Game Commission (CFGF) to change the archery pheasant season from Post general season to Pre general season to gain addition time to pursue pheasants with archery equipment. The CFGF has this scheduled for a vote and adoption during their August 7th meeting.

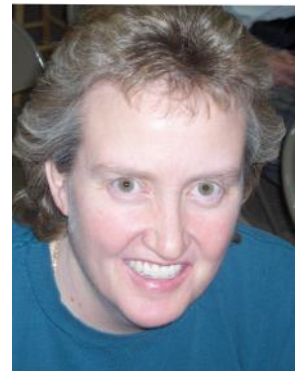

Arrow shaft numbering, what is the numbers all about?

When I started looking at equipment to buy, I had a large choice of arrows to choose from. Each brand and style all had three or more choices. Some used a 300, 400, and 500 numbering, others used a 3555, 5575, and 7595. What do these numbers mean?

The number refers to how stiff or flexible the arrow spine is. One would think that the higher the number, the stiffer the arrow, but in most cases (there are some manufactures that do use that logic) it is the opposite. When we are talking about spine stiffness, the numbering represents the deflection or bend of the arrow under a given force. The standard force test used for arrow ratings is a setup of laying an arrow across a 28 inch gap and hanging a 1.94 pound weight in the center. The amount of curve, bend, in the arrow will determine the deflection for that arrow. This deflection from straight is the basis for the numbering, represented in 1000th of an inch. A arrow that deflects half an inch, .5 inches, would have a numbering of 500 as measured in thousandths of an inch. The stiffer spine would not bend as much, thus the arrow might only bend .400 of an inch and be labeled as a 400 spine shaft. A very stiff arrow might only bend .3 inches (300/1000 or 300 thousandths of an inch) and be labeled as a 300.

Gold Tip uses a simpler number system on some of their arrow lines, they tried to help us by labeling the arrows in poundage ranges of the bow. The arrows labeled a 3555, are a good arrow for a bow with a draw weight of 35# to 55#. This made it easier for me to understand the numbering and what arrow to buy. The shelf has the same arrows with 3555 (35-55#), 5575 (55-75#), and the 7595 (75-95#). My bow pulls at 55#, so what do I buy? These rating are general rules for a average draw length and arrow tip weight. My bow is set to 55# with a draw length of 29 inches. Going by the chart them puts me right in between the two arrow, since my bow has a high FPS rating, there is a note that says I should use the stiffer spine.

Gold Tip notes:

Note: With a compound bow and release aid it is acceptable to use a shaft that is stiffer than indicated on the selection chart. This is particularly true if you want to shoot a larger diameter shaft for target and 3-D archery. **When in doubt, choose a stiffer arrow shaft. And check the manufactures website**

Carbon Express, uses a different numbering system, the higher the number the stiffer the arrow spine. Their website provides two tables to fill out to assist with the proper arrow selection. One for hunting arrows and the other for target arrows.
