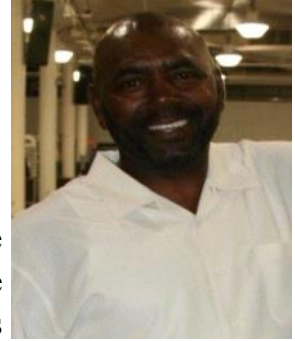
May 11 was the start of Broadhead League. This year we are having it on Saturday morning. We put out 14 3-D animals. The shot points are unmarked but there are labels on the back of the stakes for those who wish to know the yardage. We will have a flyer in the newsletter with more information.

Summer Archery League started May 2nd. This is a good way to learn how to shoot club shoots, for more information check out the flyer.

Sunday June 9th, we are going to have the Club 3-D Championship this is for members only. Awards for this will be giving out at the March 15th 2014 Maya annual banquet at Wilderness Archery. We are going to put out 28 3-D animal targets it will be a 3 arrow shoot. Saturday June 8th we are going to have a work party to set the range up if you have time come out and help.

Maya members, I have notice that members have been shooting our new bails with broadheads on the site in range and on our field course range. Broadheads are not allowed on the field course. If you need to shoot Broadhead, do it at the site in range using your own broadhead target next to the bails. Do not set your target in front of the bails. We are working on getting a pit for you to shoot into. One last thing everyone had read the rules and signed them. **SMOKING** is not allowed on the entire Maya range. If you need to smoke, please go outside the gate and smoke as much as you need to. If you get caught **SMOKING** on the range, you will be given a verbal warning. If you chose to continue to **SMOKE** on the Maya property, you will be given a letter by the Board of Directors of your violations. This could result in your loss of membership and be banned from the Maya Archery Club. The last thing we want to do is kick out members. Please help up by not smoking on the archery range.

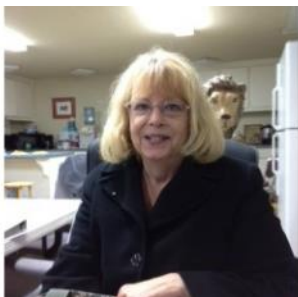

What is Nor Cal? The full name for this regional group is Nor Cal Bowhunters. They represent the areas 7 archery/bowhunting clubs and 2 archery pro shops to California Bowmen Hunters State Archery Association (CBHSAA). CBHSAA and Nor Cal are chartered to the National Field Archery Association (NFAA). What do Nor Cal and CBHSAA do for Archery or Bowhunting? There are many facets to their representation of Archery and Bowhunting. CBHSAA is "Dedicated to Promoting and Protecting the Archery and Bowhunting Heritages". This statewide organization speaks for California Archers and Bowhunters in matters concerning Legislation and Regulation since 1943. The Legislative committee of CBHSAA includes a Coordinator, 6 state area reps and each region group has one legislative representative. Archery is a shooting sport so at times issues arise to limit or exclude the shooting of Bows and Arrows for any purpose. CBHSAA will pursue those actions for the benefit of all Archers and Bowhunters. Future meeting dates, June 12th and July 10th, 7pm at the Maya Clubhouse.

It brings me great pain to inform the membership that the California Outdoor Heritage Alliance has disbanded effective the end of May. While I still don't know the whole story it is very clear their funding sources were not enough to cover business costs. It was not related to mismanagement of funds as some have suggested. In a nutshell not enough sportsmen felt it is necessary to contribute funds to assist COHA in supporting their hunting and or fishing. You can go to the Legislative page on the CBHSAA web site for an article from Bill Karr of Western Outdoor News in relation to COHA and some insight as to what may have happen.

The Legislative Committee will still be working on Archers and Bowhunters issues as usual. We just don't have an immediate advocate at the Capital. Have you been seeing articles, blogs and forums listing a number of shooting or hunting related bills or proposals to restrict your sport? I'm sometimes amazed when having conversations with individuals that they have no knowledge of pending legislation that would restrict or eliminate fishing or hunting. California is in a major crossroads in relation to shooting, hunting and fishing. CDFW sold 280,000 hunting licenses and just over a million fishing licenses, where are all those voices?

The 2013 California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) mammal regulation changes were approved by the California Fish and Game Commission April 17th. A modification to Title 14 section 354 to allow lighted nocks while hunting was approved. A small reduction in tags available for Sheep, Elk, Antelope and Deer were established due to some herd counts being lower than last year.

The next Maidu All Skills Archery Classes will be Wednesday July 17th and August 7th 6:30pm to 8:30 pm. These classes are held at the site in range far right side. During these classes the site in range is still open except for the 20 yard target for safety reasons. Thanks to all the members who have used the site in range while the classes have been held to keep safety as a priority. Maya hosted a California Department Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) Youth Archery Clinic Saturday April 27th. We had 48 youth and parents attend this 8th annual event. Everyone had fun and the only complaint was the weather was hot. The Maya members who assisted in the event, I want to say "Thank you!" for the benefit of the youth in attendance.

International Bowhunter Education Program (IBEP) class have been scheduled locally for June 14th, 15th. Classes are two days consisting of Friday evening from 6pm to 10pm at Wilderness Archery and Saturday 8am to 5pm at Maya Archery Range. Several states and countries require hunters to take this class in order to purchase bowhunter licenses, tags or to hunt during the bowhunting seasons.

Maya's Summer League began May 2nd and the turnout so far has been good. It's been quite a while since this league was set up but requests from several members interested in it have prompted its inclusion for this year's summer events. This League is separate from the 3D or Broadhead leagues to be held on Saturday's this year. The "Summer League" will be on Thursday evenings shooting NFAA Archery Field Rounds on the clubs Field Course. League will last 12 weeks alternating between Field, Hunter and Animal (paper) rounds each week following NFAA rules. The league concludes Aug. 1st, Awards and BBQ Aug. 8th. No league during the holiday weeks of Memorial and 4th of July. A minimum of 8 rounds is needed to qualify for awards. See flyer for fees, times and additional information.

One goal in starting this league back up has been requests on how to shoot the NFAA field rounds. Don't be shy or intimidated, we all have been there, persons will be available to take groups onto the course to explain and shoot the course. Handouts will be available that will explain the process & procedures of the shooting stake positions, multiple targets and scoring the targets. It's not that hard if shown how.

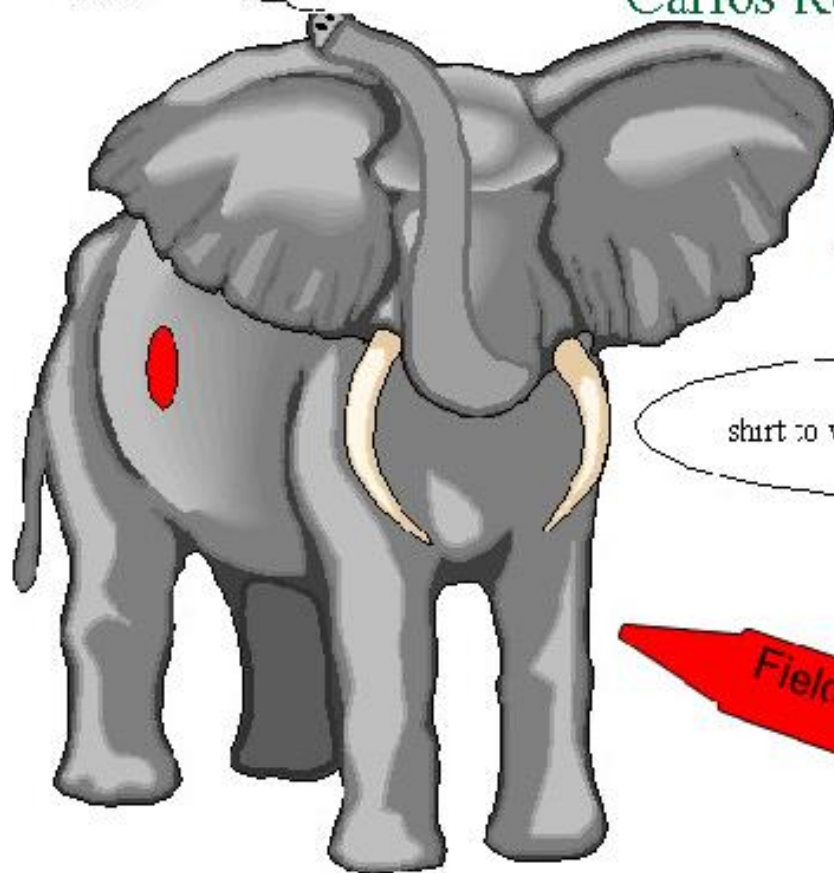

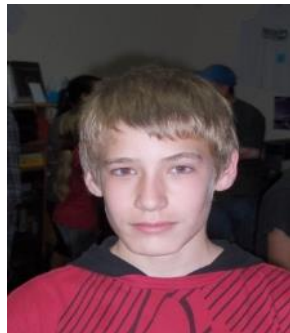

Hello fellow archers. Last month I wrote about fletching configurations, straight, offset and helical. This month I want to cover weight distribution of the arrow. This is easier to change than the fletching. I can go into the store and find many different shapes and weights of arrow tips, not even counting the broadhead set-ups. Why do I need so many choices? Why do I care?

A properly weighted arrow will have the Front of Center (FOC) balance from between 7% and 15%. This seems to be a debated topic and to the actual best ratio but the general rule is if it is around 11% or so it is fine. How do we calculate the FOC?

The FOC is a calculation of the total length of the arrow, the true center point of the arrow, and then the actual balance point of the arrow. All measurements are with the tip inserted and fletchings and nock installed.

If the FOC is way too forward, the arrow will fly the best but loose trajectory too quickly. With a FOC too far back, the arrow trajectory will be better but the arrow will fly erratic. The FOC of about 11 or so is a good balance.

How to calculate the FOC:

Measure the entire length of arrow = L

Mark the true center, this will be half the L value = C = L/2

Find balance point of arrow.

Measure to Center mark, this will be the balance Offset distance = O

Divide O by the length of the arrow (O/L) to get the FOC.

Measuring my arrows I have a total length of 29 inches = L

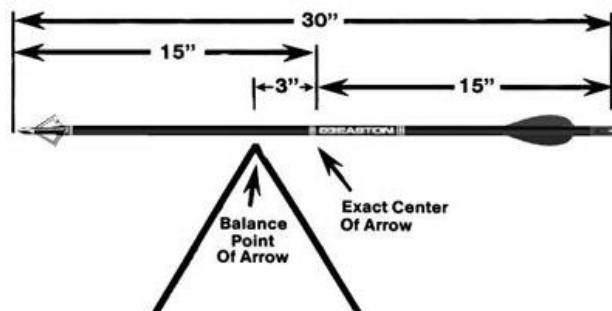
True center is 14.5 inches (L/2)

O = 3 1/8 = 3.125

This will put my FOC at $3.125/29 = .10775 = 10.8\%$

The example on the right has a total length arrow of 30 inches with balance offset of 3 inches.

Calculating the FOC in the example we get $O/L = 3/30 = .10 = 10\%$
