### Nor Cal

What is Nor Cal? The full name for this regional group is Nor Cal Bowhunters. They represent the areas 7 archery/bowhunting clubs and 2 archery pro shops to California Bowmen Hunters State Archery Association (CBHSAA). CBHSAA and Nor Cal are chartered to the National Field Archery Association (NFAA). What does Nor Cal and CBHSAA do for Archery or Bowhunting? There are many facets to their representation of Archery and Bowhunting. CBHSAA is "Dedicated to Promoting and Protecting the Archery and Bowhunting Heritages". This statewide organization speaks for California Archers and Bowhunters in matters concerning Legislation and Regulation since 1943. The Legislative committee of CBHSAA includes a Coordinator, 6 state area reps and each region group has one legislative representative. Archery is a shooting sport so at times issues arise to limit or exclude the shooting of Bows and Arrows for any purpose. CBHSAA will pursue those actions for the benefit of all Archers and Bowhunters.

The California Fish and Game Commission (CFGF) set the Big Game tag quotas at its April meeting. Reduction in tags for Sheep, Owen's valley elk, Del Norte elk, D6 deer, Northeastern Deer and Lassen antelope. Petition to list the Gray Wolf will continue discussion at the CFGF meeting in Fortuna in June. Upland bird regulation changes are also working through the Commission. Additional archery pheasant post general season for 28 days are requested. The Assembly is working on a bill that would change many aspects to hunting wild pigs.

Hello Maya members,

We are now into our Summer and Broadhead leagues. These leagues are a fun way to learn the sport of competitive archery. If you are unsure of the rules of these shoots, there will be someone who can go around to assist you. If you will need assistance, just let us know when you come in to register. The same goes for the Club Shoot the second Sunday of the month. The Summer league is Thursday evening and is a 14 target NFAA field, hunter or animal round - alternating weekly. The Broadhead league is Saturday mornings and has 14 life sized 3D animals so that you can hone your shooting skills with realistic shots. There will be very nice awards for 1st & 2nd place for the broadhead shooters. Remember, there will be an Awards BBQ after the end of each league (7-26-14 for the BH, 8-7-14 for the Summer).

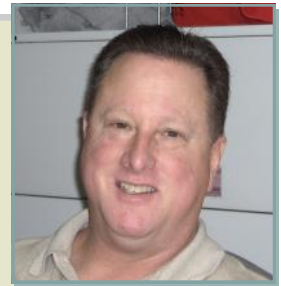
The following is new information about our range:

Our storage container was finally delivered this month. We will need to level and build ramps for it. This will give additional space to work inside the crowded work area of the clubhouse.

We also bought our own portable toilets. This will be a great savings in rental and service costs we have accumulated over the years. If you see Ken & Connie Altman at the range, give them a "Thank You". They are volunteering to keep all the toilets clean and usable. This is a big undertaking and is very much appreciated. We now have sand in the broadhead pit in-between the 20 yd and the youth bales. Remember, there will be no broadhead shooting into the sight-in range bales or the targets on the course. You may bring your own broadhead target and set it to the side of the sight-in bales or the sand pit only. Thanks for your cooperation. The 100 yd target is now useable. There is to be NO cutting of lanes to further the distance to any target.

Moving forward, I will start concentrating on our Stickbow Shoot to be held on November 2. Although it seems early, with all of the hunting seasons, the time will fly by. This is a required work special event. If you still need to fulfill your special event, please put this on your calendar.

Hope the hunters' of the club are successful this year and the scores of the target archers go up.
