


BRIEF INSTRUCTIONS FOR MEASURING PRONGHORN ANTELOPE

Measurements must be made with a flexible steel tape and recorded to the nearest one-eighth of an inch. To simplify addition, please enter fractional figures in eights and in proper fractions.

A. Tip to Tip Spread measured between tips of horns.

B. Inside Spread of Horns measured at right angles to the center line of the skull at widest point between horns.

C. Length of Horn is measured on the outside curve, as illustrated. The line taken will vary with different heads, depending on the direction of the curvature. Measure along the center of the outer curve, from tip of horn, to a point in line with lowest edge of the base, using a straight edge to establish the line end.

All adhering flesh, membrane, and cartilage **MUST** be completely removed before the drying period begins and official measurements are taken.

Drying Period: To be eligible for entry in the Club Big Game Records, a trophy must first have been stored under normal room temperature and humidity for at least 60 days after date of kill. No trophy will be considered which has been altered in any way from its natural state.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR MAYA BOWHUNTERS BIG GAME RECORDS & AWARDS PROGRAM

- **1.** Scoring form completed by active member and submitted to Hunting VP of Maya Bowhunters by February 1st.
- 2. Completion of 'Fair Chase Affidavit' on the back of the scoring form.
- **3.** At least one photo of the horns. Three photos preferred (a view from the front side, a view from the left side and a view from the right side). A field photo is also requested, if possible. Digital photos preferred.

RULES OF FAIR CHASE

The term "Fair Chase" shall not include the taking of animals under the following conditions:

- 1. Helpless in a trap, deep snow or water, or on ice.
- 2. From any power vehicle or power boat.
- 3. By spotlighting at night.
- 4. By the use of any tranquilizers or poisons.
- 5. While inside escape-proof fenced enclosures.
- 6. By the use of any power vehicle or power boats for herding or driving animals, including use of aircraft to land alongside or to communicate with or direct a hunter on the ground.
- 7. By the use of electronic devices for attracting, locating or pursuing game or guiding the hunter to such game or by the use of a bow or arrow to which any electronic device is attached.

The fair chase concept does, however, extend beyond the hunt itself; it is an attitude and a way of life based in a deep-seated respect for wildlife, the environment, and for other individuals who share in bowhunting.
